- 8 MOLLY: She wasn't a princess, she was a pirate. At least 9 she was once she married that handsome Orlando
- 10 Bloom.
- 11 JENNY: You're absolutely hopeless. Don't you understand
- that Halloween is supposed to be scary, nasty stuff with
- 13 blood and guts and ghosts and things like that?
- 14 MOLLY: It is not. You only think it is. It can be anything you
- want it to be, and I like dressing up pretty. What's wrong
- with that? When else am I going to be able to wear
- 17 something pretty like that?
- 18 JENNY: I guess you're right. I like the gross stuff. You know,
- 19 like the haunted houses, the bloody chainsaws, and the
- 20 scary music.
- 21 MOLLY: And I like the cute babies in pumpkin costumes and
- the hayrides and all that candy.
- 23 JENNY: (Eyes light up.) Oh yeah, baby, the candy! Does it
- 24 really matter what we wear? As long as we get the
- 25 candy!
- 26 MOLLY: That's right. So you go ahead and be as gross as
- you want and I'll be as pretty as I can, and I'll meet you
- at six o'clock on Friday so we can go trick-or-treating.
- 29 JENNY: I only have one request.
- 30 MOLLY: What's that?
- 31 JENNY: Don't wear glass slippers or anything. Wear
- 32 comfortable shoes.
- 33 MOLLY: Why?
- 34 JENNY: So we can hit every house in the neighborhood that
- 35 has a light on the front porch!

37. The Band

Topic: Band members try to select a name for their band.

Cast:

- ANN: the leader, full of energy
- JASON: not real hopeful about the band's future
- CHERI: trying to be helpful
- TERRY: disillusioned MIKE: comic relief
- (Scene opens with ALL sitting around. Musical instruments
- 2 can be held or in view but are not audibly played during
- 3 scene.)
- 4 ANN: Come on, guys, we've got to pick a name for our band,
- 5 like, yesterday.
- 6 JASON: What's the rush? It's not like we have a big music
 - video to film or anything.
- CHERI: Well, we might get one if we have a really cool name.
 - Everyone knows how important the power of suggestion is.
- 10 TERRY: (Discouraged) Oh, give me a break. We can call
- ourselves Purple Snot and we wouldn't get a gig.
- 12 MIKE: (Trying to lighten the mood) Wait a minute, Purple
- 13 Snot. I think that's a perfect name for the band.
- 14 CHERI: You've got to be kidding.
- 15 JASON: Of course he's kidding. I think that name's already
- 16 taken, anyway.
- 17 ANN: (Trying to be serious) I think we should put some
- 18 thought into this. What's a great band without a great
- 19 name? Where would Black Sabbath be without such a
- 20 terrific name like that?
- 21 TERRY: (Not convinced) I think that's a horrible name. It's
- the music that counts, not the name.
- 23 MIKE: I agree. Who cares what we call ourselves if our
- 24 music is good?

- 1 CHERI: You guys are totally wrong. A name is super
- 2 important. Come on, give out some suggestions.
- 3 ANN: OK, here's one Pastel Vibrations.
- 4 JASON: Good grief, what a girly name.
- 5 ANN: All right, smart aleck, you come up with one.
- 6 JASON: All right. OK, here's a great name Dashing 7 Turtles.
- 8 MIKE: I like Pastel Vibrations better than Dashing Turtles.
- 9 Does that make any sense to anyone?
- 10 TERRY: There are some really bizarre names out there for bands and things.
- 12 CHERI: Yeah, did you ever think about some of the names
- for professional ball teams? Like Florida Marlins. That's
- a fish. What's a fish got to do with baseball?
- 15 JASON: What's an oriole got to do with baseball or a raven
- with football? It's supposed to represent a place, not tell
- 17 how good the team is. Otherwise they'd name their
- 18 teams like The New York Bad-Attitude-but-Rich-Team-
- 19 Winners.
- 20 ANN: Can we please get back to the band name? Who cares
- about ball team names? We need suggestions for our
- 22 band. Come on, Terry, you're creative. Think of
- 23 something.
- 24 TERRY: How about the Green Hornets?
- 25 MIKE: Uh, taken. Don't you ever go to the movies?
- 26 TERRY: (Throws hands up in frustration.) Well, I don't know!
- 27 CHERI: All right, let's try to link the name to us personally.
- We're all really cool, good-looking kids from Baltimore.
- 29 How about The Baltimore Blue Band?
- 30 MIKE: Where did blue come from?
- 31 CHERI: I don't know. It goes with Baltimore and Band.
- 32 ANN: You guys aren't even trying. Mike, come up with
- 33 something.
- 34 MIKE: All right. Cheri is right about linking it to us. How
- 35 about The Gifted Geeks?

- JASON: Speak for yourself, geek. What an awful name.
- 2 ANN: We are getting nowhere. I guess we should all think
- about it and try this again another time.
- 4 MIKE: You're right. We'll try again later. We have more
- 5 important things to decide right now anyway.
- 6 TERRY: Such as what?
- 7 MIKE: Have we decided which one of us is going to try to
- 8 learn to play an instrument?
