## Cast:

RYCE: disillusioned, not thrilled about the prospect of baby-sitting CLEO: more appreciative of the rare opportunity to make good money

- (Scene opens with GIRLS chatting Center Stage.)
- 2 RYCE: (Glumly) I'm so bummed about tonight.
- 3 CLEO: What's wrong?
- 4 RYCE: I have to baby-sit.
- 5 CLEO: Ugh. The kiss of death. Who?
- 6 RYCE: Two brats down the street.
- 7 CLEO: How old?
- 8 RYCE: Seven and four.
- 9 CLEO: Sounds like lots of fun.
- 10 RYCE: The seven-year-old is OK, but the four-year-old is
- whiny and cries for his mom the whole time.
- 12 CLEO: Do they let you use the phone?
- 13 RYCE: Yeah, but only after the kids are in bed. Which is
- 14 never. Kevin cries and cries and I try everything but he
- 15 usually falls asleep like five minutes before his parents
- 16 come home.
- 17 CLEO: Is it good money?
- 18 RYCE: Yeah. I get twelve dollars an hour.
- 19 CLEO: (Can't believe it.) What? You're kidding.
- 20 RYCE: No. Why?
- 21 CLEO: That's a ton of money. How many hours?
- 22 RYCE: Usually no more than four. I'll probably get fifty
- 23 dollars tonight.
- 24 CLEO: (Emphatically) You've got to be kidding. Fifty dollars
- 25 for watching two kids? And no diapers?
- 26 RYCE: No, no diapers. But Kevin is a real brat, I'm telling
- 27 you.

- 1 CLEO: (Wistfully) I wish I had a job like that.
- 2 RYCE: No, you don't. I'm telling you, it's no fun.
- 3 CLEO: Since when is work supposed to be fun?
- 4 RYCE: Well, I would rather go shopping or to the movies or
- 5 something.
- 6 CLEO: I'll tell you what, I'll take your baby-sitting job and
- 7 make money and you go shopping and spend money.
- 8 How's that?
- 9 RYCE: No way! I like the money.
- 10 CLEO: So you're saying the job isn't all that bad after all?
- 11 RYCE: I hate it but I love the money.
- 12 CLEO: Ryce, we are looking at the future as adults. Like my
- dad always says, you don't have to love your work, but
- 14 you do have to work.
- 15 RYCE: (Sarcastically) That sounds exactly like the future I
- 16 want.
- 17 CLEO: Well, you don't intend to baby-sit the rest of your life,
- do you? Where else can a thirteen-year-old make that
- 19 kind of money?
- 20 RYCE: (Sighs.) You're right. Nowhere.
- 21 CLEO: Right. I'm lucky if I get ten dollars for cleaning out
- the shed. I have to ask my mom for every penny I get to

- 4 SHEILA: I'm ready! Where are we going?
- 5 BETSY: (Shrugs.) I don't care.
- 6 MARY: Where do you all want to go?
- 7 JONI: Anywhere.
- 8 MARY: Anywhere like where?
- 9 SHEILA: We could go to the movies.
- 10 MARY: (Only slightly curious) What's playing?
- 11 JONI: That new Derek Price movie is out.
- 12 SHEILA: (Disdainfully) He's a dork.
- 13 JONI: He is not. He's nice.
- 14 MARY: (With passion) I hate Derek Price. He's such a phony.
- 15 BETSY: (Whining) I don't want to go to the movies.
- 16 JONI: Well, what do you want to do?
- 17 BETSY: (Bored) I don't know.
- 18 SHEILA: We could go bowling.
- 19 JONI: (Emphatically) I hate to bowl.
- 20 MARY: Me too. I stink at it.
- 21 BETSY: (Whining) I don't want to bowl.
- 22 JONI: So what should we do? (ALL pause.)
- 23 SHEILA: We could go to Griffin's for a burger or something.
- 24 MARY: I just finished dinner.
- 25 JONI: Me too. (ALL pause.)
- 26 BETSY: This is pathetic, you know.
- 27 MARY: Yeah, we finally get a night we're all free and we
