- BOB: You're the sergeant. You tell me.
- JOE: Well, somebody's got to go out there and get to him.
- BOB: Is that an order or are you just talking out loud?
- I JOE: No. No, it's not an order.
- BOB: So, what are we going to do?
- 10 JOE: We have to make a move. Check your gun.
- 11 BOB: Yes, sir. Don't you think we ought to wait for
- reinforcements, sir?
- 13 JOE: I don't think Johnson can last that long. You ready?
