- 5 ROBIN: Oh, Pat, you fell in love once, too? I didn't know
- 6 that.
- 7 PAT: A couple of years ago. I don't like to talk about it.
- 8 ROBIN: Oh, girl, I am sorry.
- 9 PAT: Not to worry. I'm over it. But falling in love doesn't
- 10 always do that to you. Sometimes, you get soaked in it
- and it's just like bathing in happiness!
- 12 ROBIN: That's what I'm hoping for.
- 13 PAT: Yeah, me too.

Teasing

Introduction

You go to college to get an education. In this scene, PAT is enrolled in College 101: Read the Label before Consuming!

- 1 PAT: It's. Not. Funny. (She pukes into the commode.)
- 2 ROBIN: Oh, don't worry. I'm not laughing at you. I'm
- 3 laughing at what you did.
- 4 PAT: You know a friend would have told me that I was eating
- 5 dog food instead of chili!
- 6 ROBIN: I know. Sorry. I was just curious to see how far
- you'd go before you realized your mistake.
- 8 PAT: I hate him. I hate that dog. (She pukes some more.)
- 9 ROBIN: Now, now, don't blame the dog.
- 10 PAT: But I do! The little beast got in the cabinet and
- switched all the cans around!
- 12 ROBIN: Nemo is pretty smart. But I don't know if he's that
- 13 smart.
- 14 PAT: He's not smart: he's evil!
- 15 ROBIN: Oh, now, just because you don't love Alpo doesn't
- mean the dog is out to get you.
- 17 PAT: You don't know do you? You have no idea? What he
- does when we're not here?
- 19 ROBIN: What are you ? He runs around, chases his tail,
- 20 and barks out the window.
- 21 PAT: No! He does other does things. Evil things! The roast
- that disappeared last week? He ate it and stuffed the
- 23 plastic wrap between my sheets! And our clothes? You
- 24 know how they've been looking so ratty? It's 'cause he's
- been chewing on them while we're gone. And not only

1	that, when I came home early last week, guess what I
2	caught him doing? Wearing your clothes! He had on your
3	pink blouse and short set and he was wearing two pairs
4	of your shoes!

- 5 ROBIN: What?! Are you crazy?
- PAT: And not only that, but he'd he had your Dream Red
 lipstick smeared all over his mouth! (Yelping, ROBIN's
- 8 hand shoots up to her Dream Red lipstick covered lips.)
- 9 PAT: So, do you think we oughta take him to the pound 10 now?
- 11 ROBIN: Grab the car keys! That sucker is My Dream
- 12 Red?! Oh! Oh! I think I'm gonna puke!

Togetherness

Introduction

Nothing like togetherness! TINA and RINA holding hands, and facing the audience. They suddenly relax. Not to give too much away, but they are the personification of a *bra!*

- 1 TINA: What a relief! Is she ever going to lose any weight?
- 2 RINA: Well, if she doesn't, we're both going to be old before
- 3 our time.
- 4 TINA: Stretched out, worn out, and frayed. I already have
- some of my stitches working loose.
- 6 RINA: I probably do, too, but I'm afraid to look. Has she
- 7 never head of spandex?
- 8 TINA: Oh, please, how about a sports bra?
- 9 RINA: (Protesting) I am not made for aerobics! I am delicate.
- 10 I am intricate. I cost twenty-one ninety-five at Victoria's
- 11 Secret for crying out loud!
- 12 TINA: I remember how pretty we were sitting on the shelf in
- 13 the store. We were displayed so nicely. Our own special
- 14 lighting. Our own special packaging. That picture of Elle
- 15 McPherson proudly wearing us.
- 16 RINA: Oh, to belong to Elle McPherson. Now there's
- 17 somebody who'd appreciate us.
- 18 TINA: But she did appreciate us.
- 19 RINA: Yeah, when?
- 20 TINA: When she first got us. We were a Valentine gift. What
- 21 was not to like?
- 22 RINA: I think it was the divorce that did it. That made us
- just another pair to put on.
- 24 TINA: Yeah, I think you're right. You notice, she doesn't
- wear anybody much anymore. At least, not around the
