Topic: Strangers are stuck together in a stopped elevator.

Cast:

- BRIANNA: easily panicked, near the front of the elevator
- TANYA: trying desperately to keep Brianna calm, near the front of the elevator

CLAY: a friend of Will and a funny guy

WILL: friends with Clay, an average guy

CHRISTOPHER: the voice of doom, dead center in the front of the elevator

SEAN: has dry humor, is practical and logical

JAKE: nonchalant, not easily upset, and a little clueless

CORRIN: adventure lover

GABE: average guy, very practical

BRAD: not easily upset, just a normal guy

- 1 (There is no setting, but all should be obviously tightly
- 2 gathered as if on an elevator.)
- 3 BRIANNA: (Looking up and around. Gauging the atmosphere of
- 4 the elevator) Tanya, I think there's something wrong with
- 5 this elevator.
- 6 TANYA: You always think that.
- 7 CLAY: Dude, I don't think this elevator is moving.
- 8 WILL: Of course it is. You get on an elevator and it takes
- 9 you up or down. That's the plan.
- 10 CHRISTOPHER: (Very dark, very low, very ominous)
- 11 Something is terribly, terribly wrong.
- 12 SEAN: Excuse me, does anyone else feel like this elevator
- is not moving?
- 14 JAKE: Sure it is. It's fine. Don't say that.
- 15 BRAD: I'm really gonna be late now.
- 16 CHRISTOPHER: (Saying what everyone's thinking) It's not
- moving. We're stuck. We're stuck here forever.
- 18 TANYA: Don't say that. It will be fine. It's probably only

- stuck for a minute.
- 2 GABE: You don't know that.
- 3 CORRIN: This is cool.
- 4 BRIANNA: (Getting upset and spooked) It's not cool. I hate
- 5 these things. This is very upsetting to me.
- TANYA; (Trying to calm her down) Calm down, Brianna, just calm down.
- 8 CHRISTOPHER: I knew something like this was going to happen today. We're all going to die in here.
- 10 SEAN: (Voice of reason) Hey, isn't there a phone or something we can use to call for help?
- 12 BRAD: I don't have a cell phone. Do you have a cell phone?
- 13 I knew I should have gotten a cell phone. It's for times
- just like this that everyone really should have a cell
- 15 phone.
- 16 SEAN: I was talking about the elevator phone.
- 17 CLAY: What's an elevator phone?
- 18 GABE: Oh, yeah, that phone that you're supposed to use in
- 19 case of an emergency.
- 20 CORRIN: This isn't an emergency. We're just stuck a little.
- 21 It'll be fine.
- 22 WILL: How can you be stuck a little in an elevator?
- 23 CHRISTOPHER: (Continuing in his gloomy predictions) If we
- don't suffocate, then the cables will probably snap and
- the whole car will plummet to the ground and we'll all be
- 26 crushed.
- 27 GABE: Have you thought about looking into a little therapy?
- 28 BRIANNA: (The atmosphere is beginning to get edgy.) I think
- 29 I'm going to faint.
- 30 TANYA: You're not going to faint. Calm down. Everybody
- 31 just calm down.
- 32 JAKE: Does anybody have anything to eat?
- 33 CLAY: What?
- 34 JAKE: I didn't eat breakfast.
- 35 SEAN: Soooo how's it coming with that elevator telephone?

- 1 TANYA: There isn't one.
- 2 SEAN: There isn't one?
- 3 TANYA: No, there's no phone.
- 4 SEAN: I thought there was supposed to be a phone.
- 5 TANYA: Maybe there is supposed to be a phone, but there
- 6 isn't one here.
- 7 WILL: Great.
- 8 CHRISTOPHER: (In anguish) And the last thing I said to my
- 9 mother was, "You're not nice to me." What kind of last
- words are they? The rest of her life she'll be haunted by
- 11 her dead son saying, "You're not nice to me." I could
- 12 have said "I love you." That would have been the best
- 13 last words. Those are the best last words anyone can
- 14 say, "I love you."
- 15 CLAY: (Trying to be silly) Hey, Will, I love you.
- 16 WILL: (Not appreciating the attempt) Cut it out. You're
- 17 disgusting.
- 18 BRAD: Would somebody do something?
- 19 SEAN: (Trying to be logical and practical) Does anyone have
- 20 any skills that would help us get out of here?
- 21 JAKE: I can cook an omelet.
- 22 GABE: Very helpful. Come on, guys, think.
- 23 CHRISTOPHER: (Monotonously, hands raised, saying last rites
- 24 for all in the elevator) Though I walk through the valley of
- 25 the shadow of death, I shall fear no evil ...
- 26 CLAY: Oh, I saw a movie where they climbed out through the
- ceiling. (ALL look up and pause.)
- 28 GABE: Any other ideas?
- 29 JAKE: Well, we could call for help on my cell phone.
- 30 TANYA: You've got a cell phone?!
- 31 JAKE: (Holds it up.) Sure, right here.
- 32 SEAN: Somebody take that phone away from that kid so I
- 33 can strangle him.
- 34 GABE: Give me that phone you goofball.
- 35 BRIANNA: Wait! Did you feel that?

- 1 CHRISTOPHER: This is it. God bless each of you.
- 2 WILL: I think we're moving.
- BRIANNA: Up or down? (A little panicked) Up or down?!
- 4 BRAD: Calm down, girl. Up. We're going up.
- 5 TANYA: See? I told you it would be OK.
- 6 CORRIN: Oh, shoot. It's moving all right.
- 7 SEAN: I'm going to need a lot of therapy after this.
- 8 CHRISTOPHER: (Shocked) You mean we're not going to die?
- CLAY: (Just about had it with CHRISTOPHER) If you don't shut
- up, I won't be able to guarantee that.
- 11 CHRISTOPHER: You mean the elevator is not going to
- 12 crash?
- 13 WILL: It certainly looks that way. Look! The door's opening!
- 14 BRAD: Oh, I guess I'm not going to be late after all.
- 15 CORRIN: We were only in here like three minutes.
- 16 GABE: (Points to CHRISTOPHER) With this guy, it seemed
- 17 much longer.
- 18 BRIANNA: It's going to be all right. It's all going to be fine.
- 19 Everybody, we're OK!
- 20 CHRISTOPHER: I gotta call my mother. (Runs out.)
- 21 JAKE: I hope that snack shop is still open (Exits.)
- 22 TANYA: Come on, Brianna, you need a nice, warm cup of
- 23 hot chocolate. (BRIANNA and TANYA exit.)
- 24 CORRIN: Shoot, I was hoping we'd be on the news and all.
- 25 (CORRIN, CLAY, and WILL exit.)
- 26 BRAD: Nice, uh, being stuck with you. (Exits.)
- 27 GABE: What a group. (Exits.)
- 28 SEAN: It's days like today that make it a waste of energy to
- 29 get out of bed.
