The Car

Cast: Jon, Jimmy Setting: Jon and Jimmy's driveway Props: Set of car keys, wallet, gas can

- JON: (Trying to start the car) Come on, start. Come on. I'm begging you, just start.
- JIMMY: (Who has been watching JON try to start the car) Just what do you think you are doing?
- JON: Going to a party at David's.
- JIMMY: And how do you think you are getting there?
- JON: Well, Jimmy, by the looks of it, I would guess that I am taking your car.
- JIMMY: Jon, I don't know whether or not you noticed this, but in your rush to leave, you forgot to do one small thing.
- 12 JON: What? (He tries the ignition again, which still won't start the engine.) I cannot believe this. Did you put gas in the car today?
- JIMMY: No. I didn't know that it needed gas. When I used it yesterday, it had half a tank.
- 17 JON: Oh, well, I guess I ran it down last night. Got any money?
- 19 JIMMY: As I was saying, in your rush to leave for your little 20 social engagement, perhaps you forgot to ask me if you 21 could use my car.
- 22 JON: You weren't around.
- JIMMY: (Reaching in, pulling JON out of the car) Well, I'm here now, moron. Get out of the stinkin' car.
- 25 JON: What? What's the problem?

1	JIMMY: I can't believe you. (He throws Jon to one side, and
2	proceeds to shove him on every point.) First you take my
3	car last night. Then you run out the gas to fumes. Then
4	you take it tonight. Without asking! And now, you want
5	money for gas.

7	JIMMY: (Grabbing the keys from JON) It's my car, it's my gas,
8	and it's <i>my</i> money.
9	JON: (Grabbing the keys back) And I'm your brother.
10	JIMMY: Accident of birth. (He takes the keys from JON's
11	hand.)
12	JON: So, you won't let me use the car?
13	JIMMY: You don't miss a trick, do you? (He begins to leave as
14	JON tries to ask again.) Give it up, little brother.
15	JON: You are so selfish and inconsiderate. I'd let you use II
16	if it were my car.
17	JIMMY: The day you get a job and actually use your own
18	money to pay for something, we'll talk. Until then, keep
19	your greedy little hands off of my stuff. Now, get out of
20	my way, you little loser.
21	JON: (Watching for a moment, makes sure he is gone) And he
22	calls me a moron. (He looks at Jimmy's wallet that he
23	took when he grabbed his brother and counts the
24	money.) Ha, ha, yes indeedy. (He goes to the bumper of
25	the car and gets spare key.) Yes sirree bob. (He puts in one
26	gallon of lawnmower gas.) This should do it. (Turns the
27	ignition, smiles as car starts.) Yes, it's a good life!!

- MATT: You are such a jerk.
- 12 JON: Confident.
- MATT: Jerk. I don't know why you have to be such a fool. If you made it and I didn't, you better keep your mouth shut about it.
