## 9. Gossip

Topic: A play that shows the hurtful side of gossip.

## Cast:

SASHA, BRIANNA, and KIM: typical girls — chatty, gossipy, and enjoying their newfound common target COURTNEY: trying to bring some decency to the other girls

- (SASHA, BRIANNA, and KIM gather Center Stage. They are carrying school books, dressed trendy, and giggling.)
- 3 SASHA: Did you see what she was wearing?
- 4 BRIANNA: Oh, good grief, does she even own a mirror?
- 5 KIM: I think I saw shoes like hers at the Salvation Army!
- 6 (COURNTEY enters and joins the group, smiling at her friends.)
- 8 COURTNEY: What are you guys talking about?
- 9 BRIANNA: (Happy to share the gossip) Oh, Courtney, you
- should have seen what Lisa was wearing at the mall last
- 11 night.
- 12 SASHA: It was this bright blue shirt ... (Starts laughing.)
- 13 BRIANNA: And those pants ... (Laughs.)
- 14 KIM: No, the best part was the shoes. (All but COURTNEY
- 15 laugh.)
- 16 COURTNEY: (Confused and disturbed) You're making fun of
- 17 Lisa?
- 18 SASHA: (Dismissively) No, we're not making fun of her.
- 19 BRIANNA: (Still giggling a little) It's just that she was
- wearing this really funny outfit.
- 21 COURTNEY: That is making fun of her.
- 22 KIM: Come on, Courtney, it was really funny.
- 23 BRIANNA: If you had seen it, you'd be laughing too.
- 24 COURTNEY: (Trying to make her point understood) It's mean
- 25 to make fun of people.
- 26 BRIANNA: Oh, come on, you do it too.

- COURTNEY: No, I don't.
- SASHA: We don't mean anything mean by it. I like Lisa a lot.
- 4 KIM: Yeah. She's one of our best friends.
- 5 BRIANNA: If only she knew how to dress! (All but COURTNEY laugh.)
- 7 COURTNEY: (Getting angry now) You guys, it's really not nice to make fun of other people. Maybe she can't afford nice clothes like you.
- 10 BRIANNA: In her case, it's not about money. It's about taste!
- 12 KIM: It doesn't cost anything to match colors!
- 13 COURTNEY: That's not the point. It's still mean.
- 14 SASHA: (*Possibly understanding, still smiling*) You're probably right. But it *was* funny.
- 16 KIM: (Getting a little more serious) Maybe you're right,
  17 Courtney. We are sometimes mean to each other.
- 18 BRIANNA: Right. Remember how you felt, Sasha, when you
- got that new haircut last year and all the boys laughed
- at you?

- 21 SASHA: (No longer smiling and remembering with pain) Oh,
- don't remind me. I almost didn't come to school. I cried every night for a week.
- 24 COURTNEY: See? Even when people are kidding it can be really hurtful.
- 26 SASHA: Yeah, maybe you're right. It really did hurt my feelings.
- 28 KIM: We don't mean to be mean to each other. Sometimes
- 30 COURTNEY: Well, whether you mean it or not isn't the

## 10. The Sweater

Topic: A funny skit about the dynamics between girlfriends.

## Cast:

BRENDA: sly, not really honest, and trying to influence Marilyn for her own purposes

MARYLYN: innocent, kind, and a good friend who listens to Brenda's advice

- (The GIRLS are standing in front of a mirror. MARILYN has on a sweater any color but red. Both GIRLS are evaluating. An option would be to have a table of sweaters with MARILYN holding up a particular sweater instead of wearing one.)
- BRENDA: (Considering it) I don't think you should buy it.
- MARILYN: (Turning this way and that, checking out the sweater from all angles) Why not? It's fabulous.
- BRENDA: Why not? Let's see. (Counts on fingers.) It's ugly, doesn't fit you, and it costs a million dollars.
- 10 MARILYN: It is not. I love it.
- 11 BRENDA: (Throws hands up in the air, as if in surrender.) Fine.
- Buy it. But don't count on me to stick up for you when your parents yell at you for paying too much for a

- 15 MARILYN: (Beginning to show some doubt, looking a little less
- pleased with the view in the mirror) Wow, you're really
- 17 being mean. There's nothing wrong with this sweater.
- 18 It's pretty.
- 19 BRENDA: (Shrugging) If you say so.
- 20 MARILYN: I don't get you. You're the one who picked it out for me to try on.
- 22 BRENDA: Well, I didn't look at the price. And I couldn't
- really see how ugly it was until you put it on.
- 24 MARILYN: But it's your favorite color.
- 25 BRENDA: (Defensively) I like red now.
