- 20 SUSIE: Just get in the car and shut up. (To KAREN)
- Jonathan's hot! I don't care if he's a sophomore. I'm
- serious about trading dates with you. You can have
- 23 Ben.
- 24 KAREN: No, I'm good. He is cute, isn't he?

- CAMILLE: Are you alright?

- 26 CORI: He soooo doesn't know you.
- 27 DIANA: Which is why we were doomed from the start.
- 28 CORI: I never understood what you two possibly had in common.

- 1 DIANA: Eating.
- 2 CAMILLE: Ah, the food factor.
- 3 DIANA: We did have many fine meals together.
- 4 CORI: Universal bonding. You know, if the leaders of all
- 5 nations would all just sit down to a good dinner, this
- 6 old world would be a better place.
- 7 CAMILLE: May I remind you that Diana just publicly
- 8 slapped a man with a pizza slice?
- 9 CORI: Always exceptions to universal rules.
- 10 CAMILLE: Assault with Italian food.
- 11 DIANA: He deserved it.
- 12 CAMILLE: What, exactly, did he say?
- 13 CORI: Yes, how did he approach this situation?
- 14 DIANA: You want irony? He used exactly the same speech
- that I had come up with the night before. Almost word
- 16 for word. Uncanny.
- 17 CAMILLE: Details, please.
- 18 DIANA: Well, he starts off with the ever popular, "Diana,

- 22 Surrounded by people.

- 28 CORI: "I will always have a special place for you in my

- 32 DIANA: And the always comforting, "You're too good for
- me." Which, of course, is true.
- 34 CAMILLE: We've been telling you that forever.
- 35 CORI: What did you see in him in the first place?

- DIANA: His mouth.
- 2 CORI: His mouth?
- DIANA: Have you ever looked at his mouth?
- 1 CAMILLE: I'm not a mouth woman.
- CORI: It's all about the shoulders for me.
