- 1 (Scene begins with the two BOYS sitting or walking Center
- 2 Stage.)
- 3 BJ: You go ask her.
- 4 RYAN: Why should I ask her?
- 5 BJ: She likes you better than she likes me.
- 6 RYAN: That's terrific. She's your mother.
- 7 BJ: I know. That's why she likes you better.
- 8 RYAN: Maybe, but she still yells at me.
- 9 BJ: Not as loud as she yells at me.
- 10 RYAN: All right, I'll ask her, but we have to formulate a plan.
- 11 BJ: A plan?
- 12 RYAN: Yeah. You just don't go up to a mom and ask her to
- 13 do something huge. You have to work out a plan.
- 14 BJ: All right. Any ideas?
- 15 RYAN: OK. Let's see. What has she been bugging you to do
- 16 lately?
- 17 BJ: The list is long and complex, my friend.
- 18 RYAN: Let's start with the most nagged-about thing.
- 19 BJ: My room.
- 20 RYAN: Yeah, it's always the room. Why do moms care so
- 21 much about our rooms?
- 22 BJ: Yeah, it's not like she ever has to go in there or
- 23 anything.
- 24 RYAN: Well, in your case, she probably fears for your life.
- 25 BJ: Oh, ha ha.
- 26 RYAN: So what particularly about your room is she upset with?

- 1 BJ: Have you seen my room?
- 2 RYAN: Good point. You know, it's really the effort they want
- to see.
- 4 BJ: Huh?
- 5 RYAN: See, you don't really understand women like I do.
- 6 BJ: Oh, here we go.
- 7 RYAN: They don't really care what you do. It's that you
- 8 make some sort of attempt, even if it's a lame attempt.
- BJ: So I don't have to really do anything, I just have to
- 10 attempt?
- 11 RYAN: Not exactly. You have to do something. Superficial
- stuff, you know. Move some of the big stuff, throw out
- the trash, you know. It will only take a few minutes to
- make it look like you made a huge effort.
- 15 BJ: Oh, I get it. Just so she can see the rug.
- 16 RYAN: Right, now you're getting it. Clear off enough space
- so that she can see the rug.
- 18 BJ: Oh, and the laundry.
- 19 RYAN: Great! Good idea. Ask her a question about her
- 20 laundry so that she thinks you're planning on doing
- 21 laundry. Don't ask for anything then, but just ask a
- 22 question about how much detergent to use or
- 23 something. That's a great touch.
- 24 BJ: Should I offer to cook dinner or something?
- 25 RYAN: Don't overdo it, BJ.
- 26 BJ: OK, got it. You really think she'll fall for this?
- 27 RYAN: Women, especially moms, are a sucker when they
- 28 see their kids "shaping up."
- 29 BJ: How long do I have to keep this up?
- 30 RYAN: Just as long as it takes to get her in a good mood,
- 31 and then you ask her.
- 32 BJ: Won't she get mad or figure it out?
- 33 RYAN: Sure, but what do you care? You'll already have what
- 34 you want.
