- 2 GABE: (Beginning to realize his mistake) Yeah, well ...
- 3 MONICA: Now I'm upset.
- 4 JOANIE: I'm sorry, Monica, I shouldn't have just assumed.
- 5 MARCEL: Yeah, Gabe, why didn't you just ask?
- 6 GABE: Sure, like, "Hey, Marcel, why wasn't I invited?"
- 7 Right.
- 8 MARCEL: Exactly. I would have asked you if it were the
- 9 other way around.
- 10 JOANIE: I guess we didn't have all the facts.
- 11 GABE: Yeah, I guess I should have asked.
- 12 MONICA: Yeah, you should have. Well?
- 13 GABE: Well what?
- 14 MONICA: Are you coming?
- 15 GABE: Sure, I wouldn't miss it for the world!
- 16 MARCEL: Sure your little sister won't mind?
- 17 GABE: You kidding? I can't stand that little pest!
- 18 MONICA: I nominate Gabe and Joanie for the clean-up
- 19 committee! (They start walking off.)
- 20 MARCEL: I second that nomination!
- 21 JOANIE: Hey, wait a minute!

## 22. Gossip among Friends

Topic: A play based on the harm that can come from gossip.

## Cast:

SUSAN: anxious to share gossip MARY: not as gossipy as Susan JEFF: the voice of reason

- (Scene opens with SUSAN and MARY standing Center Stage
- 2 deep in conversation.)
- 3 SUSAN: Well, that's what she said.
- 4 MARY: Are you sure she wasn't talking about Jimmy?
- 5 SUSAN: No. I heard her say Adam three times in the
- 6 conversation. I know she wasn't talking about Jimmy.
- 7 MARY: Well, somebody really should tell Jimmy.
- 8 JEFF: (Enters and joins SUSAN and MARY, overhearing the end
- of the last line.) Tell Jimmy what?
- 10 SUSAN: (Pretending innocence) Oh, nothing.
- 11 JEFF: Come on, I heard you say somebody should tell
- Jimmy and he's one of our best friends. What is it he
- 13 should know?
- 14 SUSAN: (Suddenly hesitant to talk) I don't think it's my place
- 15 to say.
- 16 MARY: Oh, that's a switch. Now you don't want to be
- 17 caught gossiping.
- 18 SUSAN: It was different when I was telling you. But if I tell
- 19 Jeff ...
- 20 JEFF: (Offended) If you tell Jeff what? Are you saying I'm a
- 21 blabbermouth?
- 22 SUSAN: No, it's just that you and Jimmy are good friends
- and I don't want this getting back to him.
- 24 MARY: Well, maybe it should get back to him. It would be for
- 25 his own good if he knew. You know how sensitive Jimmy is.

- SUSAN: That's just the reason why he should know what people are saying about him.
- 3 JEFF: (Frustrated) What are they saying about him?
- 4 SUSAN: OK, Jeff, if someone heard someone say that they
- 5 had heard someone say you were seen by someone else
- 6 smoking cigarettes, would you want that someone to tell
- 7 you they had heard it?
- 8 JEFF: (Completely confused) If ... if who someone heard a
- 9 someone do what?
- 10 SUSAN: See, I told you it was stupid.
- 11 MARY: It's not stupid. You're just not explaining it right.
- Jeff, if one of your friends heard something bad about
- you, wouldn't you want to know?
- 14 JEFF: Well, that depends.
- 15 MARY: On what?!
- 16 JEFF: (Being deliberately confusing) On whether they actually
- 17 saw or heard something or whether their cousin's
- 18 brother's friend's dentist's secretary's dog heard it.
- 19 MARY: (Absolutely lost) What?
- 20 SUSAN: I think he's trying to say that gossip never helped
- 21 anyone, right?
- 22 JEFF: Right!

## 23. The Snob

Topic: A play about judging a book by its cover.

## Cast:

- JOSEPH: cheerful and friendly
- DIMITRI: obviously bitter and angry CATHY: polite but confused by Dimitri
- (Scene begins with DIMITRI sitting alone, brooding. JOSEPH
- 2 enters and joins him.)
- 3 JOSEPH: Hey, Dimitri, what's up?
- 4 DIMITRI: (Gloomily) I don't want to talk about it.
- 5 JOSEPH: Come on, it's me. You can talk to me. What's
- wrong?
- 7 DIMITRI: That new girl in guitar class is so stuck up.
- 8 JOSEPH: (Sits beside him. Seems curious) Who, Cathy? I
- 9 thought she was pretty cool.
- 10 DIMITRI: Yeah, well, you didn't go to grade school with her.
- Her father is like president of the world and her mom
- drives a Lamborghini. She's so rich it's ridiculous.
- 13 JOSEPH: So what? What's rich got to do with anything?
- 4 She's always really nice.
- 15 DIMITRI: Shhhh! Here she comes. (CATHY enters and joins the
- 16 BOYS, but does not sit.)
- 17 CATHY: Hi, Joseph. Hi, Dimitri.
- 18 JOSEPH: Hey, Cathy.
- 19 DIMITRI: (Grouchy, not looking at her) Hmph.
- 20 CATHY: (Genuinely concerned) Is something wrong, Dimitri?
- 21 DIMITRI: No, nothing's wrong. Everything is just peachy
- 22 keen.
- 23 JOSEPH: Ignore him, Cathy. He hasn't had his breakfast
- 24 today.
- 25 CATHY: I tried to get your attention during guitar class,
- Dimitri. When Mr. Reynolds said, "OK, musicians!"
