CHARACTERS

(4 Girls, 3 Guys)

Ashley: Tina's sister who isn't happy when she finds out her sister is throwing a party and didn't tell her.

Hope: Friend who eggs on Ashley's anger.

Georgia: Has an older brother, so she knows what Ashley is going through.

Adam: Guy who wants to crash Ashley's party with his friends.

Nick: Sometimes a little clueless. Adam and Chris' friend.

Chris: Friend of Adam and Nick.

Tina: Ashley's older sister who decides to throw a party without telling her sister.

SETTING

Sixth grade hallway.

- 1 GEORGIA: (Enters and walks up to ASHLEY and HOPE.) Hey 2 Ashley, I heard your sister's having a party Friday night.
- 3 ASHLEY: What? No, she's not.
- GEORGIA: Well I was turning the corner of the eighth grade hallway and just overheard her inviting a bunch of people over. A pre-dance party or something?
- 7 ASHLEY: Oh, really? Tina didn't say anything to *me* about a party.
- 9 HOPE: Probably because she doesn't want you to come.
- 10 ASHLEY: Come? It's my house, too. It's not like I have to be invited.
- 12 GEORGIA: For real. I can't believe she didn't tell you.
- 13 ASHLEY: This is so like her. I'm always the last to find out about everything.
- 15 HOPE: What do you expect? She's an eighth grader. Therefore, 16 stuck up. They think they own the school. Especially now
- that the year's almost over.
- 18 ASHLEY: (Groans.) She's going to be unbearable when she's in high school next year.
- 20 GEORGIA: You're preaching to the choir, sister! Ever since my brother went to high school, he's been a total nightmare.
- He used to be cool. Now he's just a jerk. He acts like I
- have the plague or something whenever his friends are at the house. Sometimes, he won't even speak to me.
- 25 ASHLEY: Great. So much to look forward to. (Pause) Well,
- nothing says I can't have a party, too. Right? She doesn't
- own the house. You all want to come over Friday night?
- 28 GEORGIA: That'll show her! I like it!
- 29 HOPE: We can have a Matthew McCon-athon! (Or insert current
- 30 hot movie star name) I've got all of his movies!
- 31 GEORGIA: Oh, come on, that's so lame. He's like ancient. Isn't he like forty or something?
- 33 ASHLEY: My uncle is in his forties. Gross!
- 34 HOPE: I don't care how old he is. He is smokin'!
- 35 ASHLEY: Maybe we could watch an older movie of his, when he

- 1 wasn't so old.
- 2 GEORGIA: Or we could watch scary movies instead. Anything
- 3 with an axe and a saw and I'm there!
- 4 ASHLEY: Either one works for me. I love movies. And popcorn!
- 5 HOPE: But scary movies? Axes and saws? (Grimacing) Without
- 6 boys to (Gestures air quotes around "protect" while talking)
- 7 "protect" us, what's the point?
- 8 ASHLEY: That does make sense.
- GEORGIA: Hope, you're just saying that because last time you
 got so scared you made us sleep with the lights on.
- 11 ASHLEY: Oh yeah! I forgot about that.
- 12 HOPE: I did not! I just forgot to turn the light off after I went to
- the bathroom. I was not scared.
- 14 ASHLEY: Whatever makes you feel better, Hope.
- 15 GEORGIA: Just don't forget your night light.
- 16 ASHLEY: Or your teddy bear.
- 17 HOPE: You guys are hilarious, you know that? All I really need
- 18 is Nick's arms around me.
- 19 ASHLEY: Don't we all?
- 20 HOPE: (Glaring at ASHLEY) I know you didn't just say that.
- 21 ASHLEY: Hey, you broke up with him. I'd say he's fair game
- 22 now.
- 23 HOPE: But you know we're going to get back together. Everyone
- says he still likes me. It's so obvious.
- 25 ASHLEY: What's obvious is that Nick is a single guy.
- 26 HOPE: (She gets more and more upset.) Maybe right this second,
- but you wait and see ... (ASHLEY starts laughing.)
- 28 GEORGIA: Why do you do that to her?
- 29 ASHLEY: (Still laughing) Because it's just so easy!
- 30 HOPE: (Totally confused) What?
- 31 ASHLEY: I'm just kidding, Hope! I wouldn't touch Nick with a
- 32 ten-foot pole.
- 33 HOPE: Oh. Well, that's better. Because friends really shouldn't
- 34 try to take other friends' boyfriends. Even if they are ...
- 35 (Pause) Wait a minute. What do you mean by that? You

- wouldn't touch him with a ten-foot pole? You think you're
- too good for Nick because he is the cutest and sweetest
- 3 and —
- 4 GEORGIA: Hope! Let it go and focus on the party! We'll be there
- 5 at seven, OK, Ashley?
- 6 ASHLEY: Sounds good. See you then. (ALL walk off and the boys
- enter.)

- 8 ADAM: Hey guys, want to crash a party?
- 9 NICK: Always! Whose house?
- 0 ADAM: Ashley's. I just heard she's having a sleepover with
- 11 Georgia and Hope on Friday night.
- 12 CHRIS: Ashley G? That hot girl in your math class?
- 13 NICK: If by hot you mean butter face.
- 14 CHRIS: Butter face. What's a butter face?
- 15 NICK: You know. She's hot ... But. Her. Face.
- 16 ADAM: Oh, that's so wrong! And so not true. Ashley is one of
 - the hottest girls in sixth grade. And the smartest!
- 18 CHRIS: Like way too smart to ever date you, dude!
- 19 ADAM: Girls don't like brainiac guys. You should know that,
- since you're the dumbest guy I know and you sure don't
 - have trouble getting a girlfriend!
- 22 CHRIS: Well, since I'm in between at the moment, maybe I
- 23 should consider Ashley. Now that you mention it, she is
- 24 kind of cute ... in her own way.
- 25 ADAM: Off limits, Chris. I called her. You can have Georgia.
- 26 CHRIS: Awwww, Georgia! Have you seen her play soccer? Those
- legs ... man, they're kickin'! I guess I could go for that.
- 28 NICK: You guys are so on drugs. If anyone is hot, it's Hope.
- 29 ADAM: You're just saying that because she's your ex. If she was
- 30 so hot, why'd you break up with her?
- 31 NICK: Hey, sometimes you gotta explore your options. Haven't
- you heard that expression about the grass being taller ...
- 33 or something?
- 34 CHRIS: I think you mean greener.
- 35 NICK: Whatever. I gave up Hope 'cause I thought I could get

- something better and it turns out I can't.
- 2 CHRIS: Oh, you should definitely tell her that when you ask her
- 3 to go back out with you! "Sorry, Hope. I know I made a
- 4 mistake when I broke up with you because after I looked
- around and believe me, I *looked* you really were the best option out there." That'll make her feel real special!
- 7 ADAM: I want to be a fly on the wall when you tell her that.
- 8 NICK: Look, I'm not stupid. I got her to go out with me once. I
- 9 can do it again. Everyone says she still likes me. She's
- been following me around the halls all week. Now I just
- gotta reel her in.
- 12 ADAM: Well, maybe you'll have your shot at Friday's party.
- 13 CHRIS: All I know is there'd better be some food. They'll feed
- us, right?
- 15 NICK: Man, is that all you think about?
- 16 CHRIS: Pretty much. Food and girls. What else is there?
- 17 ADAM: So we're set? We'll meet at my house since it's closest
- and walk over.
- 19 CHRIS: (He pulls a roll of toilet paper out of his backpack.) Armed
- 20 with T-P and shaving cream.
- 21 ADAM: You've got to be kidding me! Do you carry that
- 22 everywhere?
- 23 CHRIS: You never know when you might need it.
- 24 NICK: You are seriously whacked, you know that?
- 25 CHRIS: I think of myself as a Boy Scout gone wrong. Always
- 26 prepared.
- 27 NICK: Well, Mr. Boy Scout, don't forget your phone. We'll want
- YouTube videos of this! (They walk off. TINA enters to stage
- right and ASHLEY walks up to her.)
- 30 ASHLEY: So I hear you're having a party.
- 31 TINA: Funny, I was just about to say the same thing to you.
- What do you think you're doing having friends over Friday
- 33 night?
- 34 ASHLEY: Hey, it's my house, too.
- 35 TINA: Mom is never going to let us both have friends over that

- night. You know how she gets about too many people in the house.
- ASHLEY: Good thing I already called and asked her then.
- 4 TINA: What? No you did not!
- ASHLEY: Yeah, we had a sub in English who was *so* nice about letting me use the phone. Mom said it was *no* problem for me to have some friends over on Friday.
- 8 TINA: You are such a brat! Why are you always trying to copy 9 everything I do? Can't you get a life of your own?
- 10 ASHLEY: Why can't you ever include me in your life? Is that too much to ask?
- 12 TINA: I'm in eighth grade almost a high schooler. You're a 13 sixth grader. We aren't supposed to be doing the same 14 things!
- 15 ASHLEY: I'm almost a seventh grader. Just like you're *almost* a high schooler. But I'm more than that. I'm your sister.
- 17 Doesn't that count for anything?
- 18 TINA: Oh, come on! Why the guilt trip? I do stuff with you all the time.
- 20 ASHLEY: Yeah, when you aren't hanging out with your friends.
- Or when Mom makes you. And then you have to act like you're baby-sitting me instead of just hanging out. You're
- 23 only two years older, you know.
- TINA: Almost three. And we're supposed to have our own
 friends. And interests. That's just the way it is. One day
 I'll be off to college —
- 27 ASHLEY: College? Oh, come on! You haven't even started high school yet and you're already talking about college?
- 29 TINA: Look. I know you don't like it, but I am older than you.
- And things are changing. (Pause. Shows sincerity.) But I am
- sorry that we don't hang out as much as we used to when we were little.
- ASHLEY: I know! You were always my best friend. Now I barely even get to see you.
- 15 TINA: I'm sorry. I'll try harder. OK?

1	ASHLEY: Look, I know it's lame but I really miss playing
2	Barbies with you.
2	TINA D. I. O.D. II.

TINA: Barbies? Really?

ASHLEY: I said it was lame. But it used to be so much fun!
Remember how you used to take half the day setting up
your Barbie kitchen —

TINA: (Sarcastic, but loving) And how you loved coming in and
 knocking stuff over. Yeah. Real fun. (They both laugh.)

9 TINA: But you're right. It was fun. And I miss it, too. Look. I get
10 it. If I promise to spend all day Saturday with you, maybe
11 even dragging out the Barbies and if we never told a soul,
12 would you cancel your party so that I can have mine?

13 ASHLEY: Um ... Didn't you say you were almost in high school?

14 Barbies? Really? How about a day at the mall instead?

15 Deal?

16 TINA: Deal.

17 ASHLEY: Great. Now I'd better go break the news to a few people ... (Starts to walk off.)

19 TINA: How many did you invite?

20 ASHLEY: Oh, just one or two ...

(3 Girls, 2 Guys)

Ashley: Younger sister of Tina; has been threatened to leave Tina and her friends alone.

Tina: Hostess of the party. Wants her sister to stay far away from the basement.

Daniel: Funny guy. Loves to cut up.

Gregory: Loves food. Can be a little dense.

Tori: Friend who shows up late with the food. Very bubbly and happy.
