Introduction

Patience is a virtue. But maybe not always? In this scene, we find the Jones family having a picnic near the rim of the Grand Canyon until —

- 1 PAT: Mommy! Mommy!
- 2 ROBIN: What is it, honey? What's happened?
- 3 PAT: It's Tommy, Momma! He fell!
- 4 ROBIN: Fell? Where?
- 5 PAT: Over the edge!
- 6 ROBIN: Over the edge? You mean he's fallen into the
- 7 canyon? Oh, no! Where?
- 8 PAT: Here! (They both rush to the edge of the canyon and peer
- 9 down over the rim.) He's still falling, Momma. He hasn't
- 10 hit the side or anything. (Amazed) Look, Momma, he's
- waving at us. (They both wave down to him.)
- 12 ROBIN: Oh, my goodness! Sure is a long way down there. I
- 13 never realized it was so deep.
- 14 PAT: The brochure said seven hundred feet! (ROBIN turns
- away and calls off for help.)
- 16 ROBIN: Help! Help! Somebody help us! (A beat) Nobody
- seems to be around. No park rangers. Nobody.
- 18 PAT: Look, Momma! He's pulled his homework out of his
- 19 backpack and started working on it.
- 20 ROBIN: Ooooh, that boy! Just like your brother to pull a
- 21 stupid stunt like this and try to ruin our picnic, but I'll
- tell you what. (ROBIN returns to the picnic spread and starts
- preparing food. PAT comes over and joins her.) While we're
- waiting, why don't we break out this picnic basket, what
- do you say? I'm famished! I reckon we'll hear a thud or

- something when he hits bottom.
- 2 PAT: I bet ya a dollar it's more of a splat!
- 3 ROBIN: Maybe so, maybe so. Care for a chicken leg?

Introduction

This scene is done with apologies to Plain, Wisconsin. We enter this scene with JO helping PAT get ready for her first beauty pageant.

- 1 PAT: You think I can win? I've never been in a pageant
- 2 before.
- 3 JO: Absolutely. I've been in tons. It's a piece of cake. Walk.
- 4 Smile. Wave. Don't fall down.
- 5 PAT: These earrings?
- 6 JO: No, too fancy. Try these. (JO hands her another pair. PAT
- 7 puts them on. JO continues to hand her different items.)
- 8 PAT: This necklace?
- 9 JO: A bit much. Use this one.
- 10 PAT: This eye shadow? Does it go with this lipstick?
- 11 JO: Too much. Let's take a tissue to those. Tone it down a
- 12 little.
- 13 PAT: There. How's that?
- 14 JO: Better.
- 15 PAT: Look at me. Do you think I really have a chance?
- 16 JO: With this a-line dress you sewed yourself? You're a
- 17 shoo-in!
