## 25. The Class Party

Topic: Students try to plan a class party.

## Cast:

NADIA: motherly, bossy BEN: lazy, uncooperative

EBONEE: full of energy, fun-loving

ZECHARIAH: practical, does not enjoy the process

MILAN: the brain trust of the group

TAYLOR: the second boss with high energy and lots of ideas

BLAIR: bored but can be talked into cooperating

- (Scene begins with ALL sitting together in a group. NADIA
  has a pad and pencil. Others can have school props to play
- with: pencils, books, calculators, etc.)
- 4 NADIA: (Already a little exasperated) OK, we're supposed to
- 5 be working on this list. Anybody have any suggestions?
- 6 BEN: (Bored) I don't feel like doing this.
- 7 EBONEE: (Obviously a social butterfly) Come on, it will be fun.
- 8 We could have a great party if we just put a little
- 9 thought into it.
- 10 ZECHARIAH: (Obviously wishing the session was over) I wish
- she would just tell us what to bring.
- 12 TAYLOR: (Adding his input) No, this is more fun. We get to
- decide for ourselves what we're gonna do at the party
- 14 Isn't that more fun?
- 15 MILAN: (Almost mechanical, like a computer) The process of
- 16 determining our own supplies and entertainment for our
- festivities would be a very beneficial and rewarding
- 18 activity.
- 19 BLAIR: (Confused by MILAN's big words) What did he say?
- 20 BEN: Is it lunch time yet?
- 21 NADIA: (Trying to bring them back on topic) Come on, guys,
- we have to get working on this.

- 1 TAYLOR: I can bring all my CDs. I have a ton of CDs and my
- 2 music is really cool.
- 3 ZECHARIAH: (Dryly) Depends on what you mean by cool.
- 4 BEN: Got any heavy metal?
- 5 BLAIR: (Disgusted) Ew. Not heavy metal.
- 6 EBONEE: Forget about the music. What are we gonna eat?
- 7 BEN: Yeah, what are we gonna eat?
- 8 ZECHARIAH: Can't we just order pizza?
- TAYLOR: We get pizza every Friday. Can't we think of
- 10 something different?
- 11 MILAN: We might take this opportunity to explore different
- 12 dietary options.
- 13 EBONEE: (Confused) When you start talking like that I don't
- understand a bit of what you're saying.
- 15 BLAIR: He said we should try something different.
- 16 BEN: He did?
- 17 TAYLOR: I don't like different. I like pizza.
- 18 NADIA: And I like salsa music, but I don't think you'd go for
- that, would you?
- 20 ZECHARIAH: What in the world is salsa?
- 21 TAYLOR: My music collection is great. We should listen to
- 22 my CDs.
- 23 BEN: (Suddenly inspired) Fried chicken.
- 24 NADIA: What?
- 25 BEN: We should eat fried chicken.
- 26 BLAIR: (Disgusted) That's full of bad trans fats. I don't eat
- 27 that garbage.
- 28 BEN: I live on that garbage. It's good!
- 29 NADIA: We could get salad with the pizzas.
- 30 TAYLOR: (Appalled) Salad? What kind of party is this,
- 31 anyway?
- 32 EBONEE: Any party that has salad can no longer be called
- 33 a party.
- 34 MILAN: If we supplement the more unhealthy food choices
- with vegetables or other healthy alternatives, it could

- 1 counteract the negative effects of the less healthy
- 2 selections.
- 3 EBONEE: Is he speaking English?
- 4 NADIA: Come on, guys, we're never gonna get this done.
- 5 TAYLOR: And then the teacher will plan the whole thing for
- 6 us.
- 7 ZECHARIAH: (Inspired) That was my plan from the start! We
- 8 could have saved all this trouble!
- 9 BLAIR: Trouble? You think planning a party is trouble?
- 10 BEN: With you guys it is.
- 11 EBONEE: All this talking about food is making me hungry.
- 12 BEN: Is it lunchtime?
- 13 MILAN: There are still twelve minutes and forty-one seconds
- 14 left before lunch.
- 15 TAYLOR: We didn't even talk about decorations yet.
- 16 BEN: This is really sounding like a girly party.
- 17 BLAIR: Why? Because we want decorations?
- 18 NADIA: I give up.
- 19 ZECHARIAH: You all wake me up when you've decided what
- you're doing. (Closes his eyes and leans back.)
- 21 BEN: Yeah, me too.
- 22 BLAIR: (Suddenly bored) This party does sound pretty lame.
- 23 TAYLOR: Of course it does! We haven't decided on one thing
- 24 yet!
- 25 NADIA: Come on, Taylor, let's do it ourselves.
- 26 BLAIR: Wait a minute! What about Ebonee and me?
- 27 TAYLOR: (Sadly) Looks like girls outnumber boys again.
- 28 BEN: (Satisfied) Just the way I planned it.
- 29 ZECHARIAH: Yeah. Let the girls and Taylor do the work. We
- 30 can show up that will be our part. (Everyone exits
- 31 except MILAN.)
- 32 MILAN: Sometimes when dealing with inferior personalities,
- it doesn't pay to be too logical.

## 26. Do You Believe?

Topic: Twelve-year-olds discuss the age-old mystery of Santa Claus.

## Cast:

RONI: a little hard-edged, worldly TERRY: old for her age, world-wise

LONI: the last kid her age to learn the "truth"

- (Scene begins as ACTORS are sitting around on a sofa, or
- 2 playing video games.)
- RONI: Hey, Terry, what are your parents getting you for
- Christmas?
- TERRY: I asked for a computer and TV for my room. I'll
- probably get clothes and junk I didn't ask for.
- 7 LONI: (Sincerely) What about Santa Claus?
- 8 TERRY: (Clearly not having heard correctly) Huh?
- 9 LONI: Well, did you ask Santa Claus for anything?
- 10 RONI: (A little concerned) Are you feeling OK, Loni?
- 11 LONI: Sure. Why?
- 12 RONI: Did you say "ask Santa Claus"?
- 13 LONI: Yes, of course.
- 14 TERRY: (Suspiciously) Did you ask Santa Claus for anything,
- 15 Loni?
- 16 LONI: Absolutely. I always ask for things and I get what I
- want. Within reason, of course.
- 18 TERRY: (Beginning to become worried about her friend) Let me
- 19 get this straight. You actually go to the mall and sit on
- 20 that guy with the beard's lap and read from your goody
- 21 list?
- 22 LONI: Of course not.
- 23 RONI: Thank heavens.
- 24 LONI: (Reasonably) I write him a letter.
- 25 TERRY: (Appalled) You've got to be kidding.
