## Job Preps

Cast: Margaret, Caroline, Bernadette, Melinda
Setting: Margaret, Caroline and Bernadette are at
Melinda's house helping Margaret find just the
right outfit to wear for her job interview.

Props: Margaret has a variety of different outfits,
Melinda has a purse with Oreos in it,
Bernadette has a bottle of water.

- 1 MARGARET: So, do you like this dress?
- 2 CAROLINE: It's fine.
- 3 BERNADETTE: Can we just make a decision and go?
- 4 MARGARET: I think it makes me look fat.
- 5 MELINDA: You look fine. Take the stupid thing and let's go
- 6 MARGARET: My hips look like two overripe watermelons
- 7 wiggling away under this thing.
- 8 CAROLINE: Then don't use it, Margaret. Try on something
- 9 else.
- 10 BERNADETTE: I've got to get going ... Vinnie's waiting for
- 11 me ...
- 12 MELINDA: (Cutting her off) Vinnie's waiting for me ... Yeah
- 13 we know, Bernadette. We don't care.
- 14 BERNADETTE: Jealous, Melinda?
- 15 CAROLINE: I'm starving.
- 16 MARGARET: I told you to eat before we came over to
- 17 Melinda's.
- 18 CAROLINE: I did eat. That was six hours ago. My
- 19 metabolism is normal, my food has been digested, my
- 20 blood sugar is dropping and so am I.
- 21 MELINDA: Stop complaining. (Reaching in her purse) Have
- 22 a cookie.
- 23 CAROLINE: I can't just eat a cookie. It's too dry. If I pass out
- 24 I hold all of you responsible.
- 25 BERNADETTE: Oh, for heaven's sake. Eat the cookie.

- CAROLINE: Dry? I'll choke to death.
- MARGARET: Should I try on the red dress?
- BERNADETTE: Here, drink some of my water to wash it down with.
- MELINDA: Take the one you have and let's get going. We all have things to do.
- CAROLINE: Melinda, give me something from the fridge.
- MELINDA: My mom's dieting. There's nothing in there but two pieces of sliced jicama and tofu.
- (AROLINE: Never mind. Give me the cookie.
- MARGARET: Give me a cookie, too.
- (CAROLINE: Oh, so now you're hungry, too?
- MARGARET: Oreos? I don't really care for Oreos.
- MELINDA: (Reaching again into her purse) How about a Strawberry Newton?
- **M** CAROLINE: I want that.
- **IV** BERNADETTE: You already took a bite out of the Oreo.
- **III** CAROLINE: I can't have both?
- MELINDA: (Flinging her purse to the floor in front of them)
  Oh, jeez, just help yourselves.
- BERNADETTE: Hey! Don't put your mouth on my bottle.
- MARGARET: I am going to try on the other one I left in the bathroom. I'll be right back. (Exits.)
- MELINDA: We are never going to get out of here.
- BERNADETTE: Why are we even here? Does anyone care less than I about what Margaret wears on her job interview?
- CAROLINE: (Quietly) Why is she bothering? She's not going to get the job.
- 10 MARGARET: (From Off-stage) I can hear you, ya know.
- 11 CAROLINE: (Loud enough to be heard) You're not going to get the job.
- 13 MARGARET: You don't know that.
- BERNADETTE: Who cares? Can we go? Vinnie and I are going to an accordion concert tonight.

- 1 MELINDA: Yeah, wouldn't want to be late for that.
- 2 BERNADETTE: (Flatly, an old argument) Shut up.
- 3 CAROLINE: Why are you even going in for this interview?
- 4 MARGARET: Why not?
- 5 MELINDA: How about lack of qualifications?
- 6 MARGARET: (Coming out in the new dress) Please. How
- 7 qualified do you have to be?
- 8 CAROLINE: Oh, let's see. You are applying for an aerobics
- 9 instructor job. Perhaps you should know aerobics.
- 10 MARGARET: You dance around, sweat and just shout out
- 11 the occasional "You go, girl!" or "Dig in! Dig in!" How
- difficult can that be?
- 13 BERNADETTE: Well, when you drop dead of your stroke,
- we can all use it as an excuse to buy a new black outfit
- You are the most out-of-shape person I know.
- 16 MARGARET: Am not.
- 17 BERNADETTE: Are too.
- 18 MARGARET: Not!
- 19 BERNADETTE: Are!
- 20 MARGARET: Not!
- 21 BERNADETTE: Are!
- 22 MARGARET: Not!
- 23 MELINDA: When you two are done with this witty
- conversation, perhaps we can move on.
- 25 MARGARET: Listen. Maybe I should wear dance tights with
- a little flowy skirt over it.
- 27 BERNADETTE: Bad fashion choice.
- 28 CAROLINE: I hope you get this job, just so I can see you
- 29 attempt to do aerobics.
- 30 MARGARET: You want to see? Come on, right now. Let's go.
- 31 CAROLINE: You'll drop dead right in front of us.
- 32 BERNADETTE: So, are you wearing the dress you have on?
- 33 It looks fine. Melinda, take me home.
- 34 MELINDA: You don't know she'd drop dead.
- 35 CAROLINE: Dead as a doornail. Dead as last season's shoes,

- dead as dead person. Dead.
- MARGARET: Shut up. I'll be fine.
- BERNADETTE: Melinda, I have your keys, let's go.
- MELINDA: Margaret, Caroline has a point. You know you don't just stand there, you have to move with them.
- MARGARET: I'm not stupid. I watch those exercise shows.
- / CAROLINE: From your couch.
- BERNADETTE: If I'm late for that concert, Vinnie's mom will never forgive me.
- **MARGARET:** Have you ever done aerobics?
- CAROLINE: A couple times. I don't live under a rock, ya know.
- BERNADETTE: She's playing lead accordion. I can't walk in late. It would be rude.
- MELINDA: Margaret, do you have a routine figured out?
- **MARGARET:** For what?
- 17 MELINDA: What if they ask you to audition?
- **III MARGARET: Audition??**
- 10 CAROLINE: You're screwed.
- BERNADETTE: Good. That's decided. Melinda, take me home.
- 12 MARGARET: I can make something up, I guess.
- 3 CAROLINE: You're screwed.
- MARGARET: I really want this job. Have you seen how many cute guys go into this club?
- 26 MELINDA: We should help her out.
- 27 CAROLINE: How?
- 28 MARGARET: I remember some stuff from that Richard
- 29 Simmons video.
- 30 MELINDA: Do you have any oldies music?
- 31 CAROLINE: Why does she need music?
- 32 MELINDA: So she can lead us in an aerobics lesson and we
- 33 can help her out with some ideas.
- 34 BERNADETTE: That would involve sweat, wouldn't it?
- 35 MARGARET: How's this one? (She names a song from the '50s.)

- 1 BERNADETTE: Sweating? I sweat for no one.
- 2 MELINDA: You want a ride home?
- 3 BERNADETTE: Like twenty minutes ago.
- 4 MELINDA: Give us just a while to help Margaret out, then
- 5 we can go.
- 6 MARGARET: Come on, Bernadette. I need this job. My cash
- 7 is running low.
- 8 CAROLINE: That will happen when you spend it all on stuff
- 9 you don't need.
- 10 MARGARET: I needed that faux fur hat.
- 11 CAROLINE: Yeah. You really need to walk around with the
- 12 fake carcass of some poor animal perched on your
- 13 head.
- 14 MARGARET: Some of us care about fashion.
- 15 BERNADETTE: Some of us care about getting to our
- 16 appointments.
- 17 MELINDA: It's only an accordion concert. Unless Drew
- 18 Carey is hosting it, you will be missing nothing.
- 19 BERNADETTE: But Vinnie ...
- 20 MARGARET: Boyfriends come and go. Friends last a
- 21 lifetime.
- 22 BERNADETTE: A lovely Hallmark sentiment. You've got
- one song, and then we have to go!
- 24 MARGARET: OK.
- 25 BERNADETTE: One song.
- 26 MELINDA: This will be fun. We can all use a good workout!
- 27 CAROLINE: I sense disaster.
- 28 MARGARET: You guys line up over here. (CAROLINE,
- 29 MELINDA and BERNADETTE form a line facing
- 30 MARGARET.) Now, the song. (She pushes play and begins to
- 31 "do aerobics," CAROLINE, MELINDA and BERNADETTE
- 32 follow her frenetic moves.) Yeah! Go! Scoop down, scoop
- 33 down! (The music and routine should last a minimum of
- two minutes, no longer than three before the last girl
- 35 drops out. As she continues, they all become out of

- breath, dropping out, quitting. They sit in exhausted silence for a moment, breathing heavily.)
- CAROLINE: (Deadpanned) This was fun.
- BERNADETTE: I have to take a shower. I'm sweating.
- MELINDA: We're out of shape. Maybe we should all join a gym.
- CAROLINE: Just give me another cookie
- MARGARET: (Gasping for breath) I wonder if that job at Taco Bell is still open.
