- 1 (As this scene begins, we find STAN watching OLIVER busily 2 scratching himself.)
- 3 STAN: What are you doing, Ollie?
- 4 OLIVER: What am I ? What does it look like I'm doing.
- 5 Stanley?
- 6 STAN: It looks like you're scratching.
- 7 OLIVER: That's right. That's what I'm doing. I got up this
- 8 morning and got dressed and now I'm itching all over
- 9 So help me. Scratch my back! (STAN starts scratching
- 10 OLIVER's back.) No, over here, over here.
- 11 STAN: Here?
- 12 OLIVER: Yes, yes. Ooooh, yes.
- 13 STAN: Feelin' better?
- 14 OLIVER: A little, but oh but now my arms are itching!
- (OLIVER starts scratching his arms. Then, he starts scratching
- his legs. STAN all the while is scratching his back. As the
- scene proceeds, OLIVER is wildly scratching everywhere.)
- 18 STAN: Stand still. Stop dancing so.
- 19 OLIVER: I can't help it. It's just getting worse. Over here!
- 20 Over here! Scratch harder!
- 21 STAN: You sure are irritable today.
- 22 OLIVER: You'd be irritable, too, if you were itching like me.
- 23 STAN: I think you have "irritable irritation" syndrome! You
- 24 should learn to relax better.
- 25 OLIVER: Oh, do be quiet, Stanley. Oh! I'm itchy all over! I

wish I knew why this was happening.

STAN: Oh, I don't know, Ollie, maybe it was that bottle of itching powder I split in your suitcase!

OLIVER: You did what!? Ooooh, you! (OLIVER hits STAN with his hat and then chases STAN off the stage.)
