Meow. GERTIE

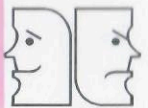
SHERYL

Yeah, it said if I call the pound, it's going to scratch my eyes out.

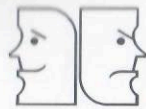
PATTY

Kid, you touch me and I'll rip your hair out.

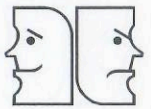
PATTY
