Introduction

In this scene, SUZY, a soon-to-be bride, gives her friend JILL a tour of her very organized newlywed apartment. JILL has just opened a pantry door to look at the canned goods.

- 1 SUZY: I came over every day this last week and worked on
- 2 organizing everything. The kitchen. The closets. The
- 3 bathroom. That way, when we get back from Honolulu,
- 4 the apartment will be all ready for us.
- 5 JILL: Did you do this? (JILL holds out a tin can with no label
- on it.) Take all the labels off the canned goods?
- 7 SUZY: What? Let me see. Oh, my gosh. They've taken all
- 8 the labels off! I can't believe who did this? Now, how
- 9 how am I going to know what I'm opening?
- 10 JILL: I guess you won't. It'll be "cook's surprise"!
- 11 SUZY: No! No! I can't deal with this. This is too much.
- 12 JILL: Oh, Suzy, it's just a joke. Lighten up. This gets done
- 13 to lots of newlyweds.
- 14 SUZY: But not to me. I had everything in place. I had it
- organized. I had it all organized!
- 16 JILL: Oh, loosen up, Miss Suzy Homemaker. We've got a
- 17 wedding tomorrow night!
- 18 SUZY: But who who could have done this? Oh, no! You
- don't think they messed with the rest of the apartment,
- do you? (SUZY rushes off. A moment later, she screams. A
- beat later, she stumbles back in, dazed.) Oh, no! It's rulned!
- The whole place! The closet. The bathroom. They look
- 23 like a tornado's hit!
- 24 JILL: Come on, Suzy, I'm sure it'll be OK.
- 25 SUZY: I'm a failure. How's Todd gonna love a wife who can't

2	JILL: Oh, stop! You're overthinking this thing, Suzy, Todd's
3	a guy. I'm sure your organizational skills are not at the

5	SUZY: You mean, if I keep him distracted, he won't notice

7	JILL: You keep him "distracted" and he'll think he's still in

Introduction

Patience is a virtue. But maybe not always? In this scene, we find the Jones family having a picnic near the rim of the Grand Canyon until —

- 1 PAT: Mommy! Mommy!
- 2 ROBIN: What is it, honey? What's happened?
- 3 PAT: It's Tommy, Momma! He fell!
- 4 ROBIN: Fell? Where?
- 5 PAT: Over the edge!
- 6 ROBIN: Over the edge? You mean he's fallen into the
- 7 canyon? Oh, no! Where?
- 8 PAT: Here! (They both rush to the edge of the canyon and peer
- 9 down over the rim.) He's still falling, Momma. He hasn't
- 10 hit the side or anything. (Amazed) Look, Momma, he's
- waving at us. (They both wave down to him.)
- 12 ROBIN: Oh, my goodness! Sure is a long way down there. I
- 13 never realized it was so deep.
- 14 PAT: The brochure said seven hundred feet! (ROBIN turns
- away and calls off for help.)
- 16 ROBIN: Help! Help! Somebody help us! (A beat) Nobody
- seems to be around. No park rangers. Nobody.
- 18 PAT: Look, Momma! He's pulled his homework out of his
- 19 backpack and started working on it.
- 20 ROBIN: Ooooh, that boy! Just like your brother to pull a
- 21 stupid stunt like this and try to ruin our picnic, but I'll
- tell you what. (ROBIN returns to the picnic spread and starts
- preparing food. PAT comes over and joins her.) While we're
- waiting, why don't we break out this picnic basket, what
- do you say? I'm famished! I reckon we'll hear a thud or
