- 10 BRIANNA: (Shocked) A year? What? That can't be!
- 11 CLIFF: Women. Never on time.
- 12 JAMAL: What happened?
- 13 BRIANNA: Well ... I don't know ... I thought I was supposed
- 4 to come up now.
- 15 JAMAL: Last year.
- 16 CLIFF: You're only off by a year. Don't feel bad.
- 17 BRIANNA: Oh, goodness, how could this have happened?
- (Thinking it over. Obviously very upset) Oh, dear! What am
- I going to do? Everyone's gone and I'm a whole year late!
- 20 CLIFF: (Trying to console her) Oh, don't be upset. It's not that
- 21 bad.
- 22 BRIANNA: (Through her tears) It's not?
- 23 JAMAL: No, you didn't miss much last year.
- 24 CLIFF: Yeah, everyone was so grossed out by the thousands

- and thousands of your friends, they never would have appreciated your ... (Looking for a nice word) uniqueness.
- 3 BRIANNA: (Sounding hopeful) My uniqueness?
- 4 JAMAL: Sure. You have a beautiful ... (Searching for
- 5 something nice) um ... purple body.
- 6 CLIFF: And such lovely ... unique ... effervescent wings.
- 7 BRIANNA: (Preening) Do you think so?
- 8 CLIFF: (On a roll) Sure! You'll be the talk of the town. And
- 9 just think of all the people who missed the whole thing
- last year. Maybe they were away or something and didn't
- get to see your friends. You'll be special.

19. Mad Cow Disease

Topic: Two cows discuss human behavior from their perspective.

Cast:

CLOVER

BUTTERCUP

Costumes

Students do not need to dress as cows but may. A simple costume would be white sweats with black patches and headband with ears. They stand, not crawl on all fours.

(CLOVER and BUTTERCUP are Center Stage.)

- 15 BUTTERCUP: (Laughs.) How humiliating. I'm glad I was
- never chosen to go the fair.
- 17 CLOVER: It's bad enough that we get those school tours.
- 18 BUTTERCUP: Oh, you should have seen that group that
- 19 came through last week. They came into the milking
- station and this little kid yells, "Hey, is that a girl cow
- or a boy cow?"
- 22 CLOVER: That's nothing. How about the people riding by in
