Yeah a lot better. I just won twenty-five dollars.

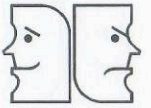
CLINT

Yes!!

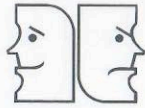
ERIN

ERIN

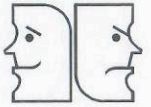
That's disgusting!
