 What's the nicest gift Gary's ever given you?
 - JO: I don't know. He always has to give me new ones. I'm like a Lamborghini. I must constantly be fine-tuned.
- PAT: Hope Gary's rich. You're pretty high maintenance. See you changed your hair again.
- JO: Yep. That's right! From brunette to blonde and my eyes
 are the same way. Today, they're purple. But tomorrow
 they may be blue or green or violet. It just all depends
- on my mood. And why not? Not everybody wants to be
- 13 as simple as you are Pat.
- 14 PAT: Yeah, that's me. "Simple" Pat, and you're
- "Kaleidoscope" Jo, 'cause nobody knows how you're

- PAT: We shouldn't be doing this! If Daddy finds out we're out here snooping in his stuff, he'll ground us forever.
- JO: Relax! Him and Mom are gone to the mall. OK? We're just going to look. We're not going to take anything.
- PAT: So, what happened again?
- 6 JO: I walked out here while he was looking at something in 7 this box and when I said, "Whatchaya doin'?" he just
- 8 about jumped out of his skin and slammed this lid really

- 10 PAT: You startled him. Look, the lid's not even locked. Can't
