1 climb on top. What I am saying is that you're a man 2 and she's a woman. Take it from there. SAM: I'm a man and she's a woman. I never thought of it 3 4 that way. That makes it a little clearer, doesn't it? RICK: All you have to remember is that you're the man 6 You're the one in charge. Assert yourself. Let her know 7 that you're in command of affairs at hand. 8 SAM: Affairs at hand? You didn't say anything about an 9 affair being at hand. Oh, gosh, I think I'm going to be 10 sick. 11 RICK: Sam, Samster, pal. Just remember, she's probably in 12 nervous as you, maybe more so. After all, she's the one 13 who wanted to meet you. This was her idea. 14 SAM: It was? 15 RICK: Yeah. She's really interested. (Taking him by the 16 shoulders) Now, stand proud. Be a man. Pull yourself 17 together, and let's go out and divide and conquer. 18 SAM: Divide and conquer. Real men. I'm in charge. I am the 19 man. 20 RICK: Good! Now you've got it. Onward to face the enemy, 21 SAM: Onward! (He stops.) Just a minute. 22 RICK: What now? 23 SAM: I've got to throw up. Wait here.

The Fight

Cast: Josh, Rick, Matt
Setting: Outside, perhaps in an empty parking lot

JOSH: (Pacing nervously, he looks around, clearly waiting for someone to come.) Where is he? Darn it. (Finally, he sees someone approaching.) Awesome! Rick! Over here!
RICK: You're an idiot.
JOSH: Yeah, I know. Thanks for coming.
RICK: One of these days I'm not going to be able to make it to save your butt, then what are you going to do?
JOSH: It'll never happen. You're my best friend. It's your obligation. You know I'd do the same for you.

RICK: Yeah, that'll happen. I can fight my own battles.

1 JOSH: But, if you ever need backup, I'm there. You can

count on it.

RICK: Yeah, great. So, where is this guy?

JOSH: He said he'd be here tonight at eleven o'clock. It's ten after. Maybe he's not coming.

16 RICK: Shauna's waiting for me to come over to take her to

JOSH: No problem. I came. My pride is intact.

- 19 RICK: So, you're the guy that wants to fight Josh?
- 20 MATT: Yeah. Little punk hit on my girl.
- 21 RICK: Yeah, he does that a lot. He doesn't mean anything by

- 23 MATT: How do you know him?
- 24 RICK: Our families have been friends forever. He's like my
- 25 little brother.
- 26 MATT: That's a shame. I'm gonna have to pound him.
- 27 RICK: Hmmm. Well, I'm afraid I can't let you do that.
- 28 MATT: What? He hit on Paige. You know we've been going
- out since May. She's my girl.
- 30 JOSH: What? Did you put your mark on her?
- 31 RICK: Shutting up about now would be good, Josh.
- 32 JOSH: Sorry ...
- 33 RICK: Josh, did you not know that she had a boyfriend?
- 34 JOSH: I told you, I didn't. She didn't act like she did.

- 1 JOSH: She flirted with me. She smiled.
- MATT: So you kiss her?
- JOSH: No! (RICK gives him a look.) OK, maybe. But she didn't kiss back, so I backed off. That was it.
- MATT: Time to throw down.
- RICK: Matt, I don't think so.
- MATT: This isn't your business, Rick.
- RICK: I'm making it my business. You and I are friends
- from school, but Josh is like family. You're going to
- have to go through me to get to him. That's just the way it is.
- 12 MATT: I'm not here to fight you.
- 13 RICK: I don't want to fight, either. Shauna is waiting for me
- to take her to Tom's party. Josh is an idiot, but he's
- 15 harmless.
- 16 JOSH: That's true ... wait a minute ...
- 17 RICK: He hit on your girl, she didn't respond, he backed off,
- end of story. Now, if you want to make more of this, we
- can. But, I repeat: You will have to go through me to get
- to him, and I think we both know how that will end up.
- 21 MATT: (He evaluates the situation.) Whatever, dude. You
- know I respect you, so it ends. (To JOSH) For now. But
- you better stay away from Paige.
- 24 JOSH: No problem.

- 25 MATT: And maybe you better investigate a situation before
 - you start putting your lips on a girl you don't know.
- 27 RICK: I've been telling him that since he hit puberty.
- 28 JOSH: I can't help myself.

- 31 RICK: (Holding out his hand) Thanks, Matt.
- 32 MATT: (Shaking his hand) Not a problem. (To JOSH) See you
- 33 around, punk. (Exits.)
- 34 RICK: (Smacking JOSH on the head) Idiot.
- 35 JOSH: I know. So, we going to Tom's party?

- 1 RICK: Can you keep yourself focused on just girls you
- 2 know?
- 3 JOSH: I'll do my best.
- 4 RICK: Loser. Let's go.
- 5 JOSH: Hey, Rick. Thanks.
- 6 RICK: Yeah, yeah. (They exit.)

Cast: Alex, Dylan Setting: The school hallway

- ALEX: Dylan ... Hey, Dylan, wait up.
