Life Lesson 1: don't spend more than you have coming in.

JAMIE

What's that?

JULIE

Something my father taught me. Don't spend what you don't have.

JAMIE

But I did have it. It just means I can't go skiing.

JULIE

Life Lesson 2: You have to make choices.

JAMIE

Uh, excuse me? I think I did. I chose the sweater. Which'll keep me nice and warm while I'm writing that term paper that's due tomorrow.

JULIE

Life Lesson 3: Don't put off until tomorrow what you can do today.

JULIE

(Lying on her side.) That was uncalled for.

JAMIE

It was, like, totally called for.

JULIE

Rule Number 7: No one is without sin.

JAMIE

Rule Number 8: Let he who is without sin cast the first stone, idiot.

JULIE

(Getting up and dusting herself off.) Hey. Does this Joel have a friend?

JAMIE

A friend? Of COURSE he has friends!

JULIE

Could we maybe go on a double date? I think maybe my parents would let me, if he was nice. (JULIE adjusts her glasses.)

JAMIE

With YOU?

JULIE

Listen. I wasn't trying to be mean to you. It's just, you're so popular and everything. When you were assigned to be my science partner I couldn't believe we'd be working together.

JAMIE

Really?

JULIE

You even wear makeup.

JAMIE

Julie, EVERYONE wears a little.

JULIE

I don't.

JAMIE

Well, you should. Just some mascara and a touch of lip gloss would help.

JULIE

Really. So could we go on a double date?

JULIE

I always wanted to be cool. Like you.

JAMIE

Life Lesson Number 9: Don't rule anyone out. (She puts her arm through JULIE'S and they start walking offstage.) Let's go to the park, and pick up some bread on the way at the bakery and feed the ducks.

JULIE

(Smiles.) Okay.

JAMIE
